Warranty Document

Approach and construction

Throughout the development of the Maguire Boats Exocet we have strived to develop a moth that is lightweight, strong and as durable as we can make it, by using high quality materials, careful construction techniques and rigorous testing.

We have selected the best materials possible for the hull and foil construction, we use high modulus fibres in areas of highest load and stress, especially in the foils.

During construction we cure both hull and foils in an oven at a temperature of 75 degrees for 6 hours this complete posture cycle and ensures we get the best properties possible from our carbon laminates.

The boat has been constructed to ensure it remains a lightweight composite structure to an acceptably competitive weight tolerance.

Warranty Cover

Maguire Boats warrants the Exocet Moth to be free from defects in materials and workmanship for 12 months from invoice date. This warranty applies to the original owner only and is non-transferable. A full inspection of the Moth must be made immediately upon receipt and any issues should be raised directly with Maguire Boats. This warranty covers the hull, complete wing platform assembly, main foil and rudder foils, and associated parts provided to the builders' specification at the time of purchase, against defects in materials and workmanship for the period of the warranty.

Warranty Exclusions

Maguire Boats is not liable for imperfections and damage to the products as designed, produced, and provided, if so, caused by, or resulting from:

- A sailor(s) weight over 100kg
- improper or forced assembly,
- wear and tear: including scratches or paint chipping,
- neglect of use and general maintenance (especially any damage from over pressuring by leaving bungs in, in hot weather),
- unauthorised modifications,
- sailing or racing in over 25 knots average wind strength,
- the attachment of non-approved additional accessories or functions,
- sailing or racing incidents or accidents with a third party, hidden object or contact with the bottom,
- uncovered storage and prolonged exposure to direct sunlight or heat,
- transportation or storage,
- non-approved repairs by a third party,
- if sailed or raced two-up,
- acts of vandalism,
- Use of non-OEM foils.
- Improper handling,



- Use in commercial, rental or teaching environments.

Parts excluded from warranty:

- Wand/ bow sprit assembly,
- Tiller and tiller extension,
- Trampolines.
